## PART- B. SANITARY INFORMATION

The undersigned Official Veterinarian certifies that the donor animal:

- a) showed no sign of disease on the day of collection.
- b) satisfies the following requirements:
  - 1. was born or has lived in the country of export for last six months prior to collection of semen.
  - has been immunized against rabies, canine distemper, canine parvovirus, canine adenovirus, canine corona virus and leptospirosis following the vaccination schedule prescribed by the vaccine manufacturer; and is free from these diseases.
  - 3. has been tested for canine brucellosis (Brucellacanis) 3 to 6 weeks after the final collection of semen for this consignment with a negative result.
  - 4. The animals resident in the semen production Centre are subjected to regular health check by the veterinarian of the Centre and have not shown clinical sign of any infectious or contagious diseases transmitted through semen including canine herpes virus infection, in six months prior to semen collection.
  - The semen is being transported in containers that are new or that have been cleaned and disinfected in a manner acceptable to Government officials of the exporting country; the semen is not known to contain pathogenic organisms.
